## Water Supply Update

Thank you to all residents for your patient following the recent water leak, which has now been fixed.

Following the extraordinary Parish Council meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025 the Parish Council have resolved to apply for a Public Works Loan Board Loan 'in principle' to cover the costs of the new water treatment plant needed. As an alternative option to the loan a resolve was also made to ask all households for a one-off payment to cover the costs. The two options will involve a consultation process with the community to gauge public support. The water committee (funding and management) are currently working out how the consultation process will be formed and a letter to all households explaining the procedure and options will be forthcoming. Please bear with us as the water committee are all volunteers and this can be a time-consuming process. Thank you.
